EVENTS

2024 was an eventful year! Our FUNdraising events continue to draw returning and new visitors to Maybury Farm. With our faithful friends continuing to attend, we were excited to expand our reach outside of the Northville Community, with more visitors from more distant, surrounding areas including Westland, Brighton, Ann Arbor, Bloomfield Hills and more! Events included our traditional favorites - Maple Syrup Tours, Farm Fest, the Great Fall Festival, Corn Maze and Holiday Fun & Santa Visits - there is something for everyone to enjoy while supporting Maybury Farm!

EDUCATION

Not to be outdone, our Education Programs saw an increase in program participation with almost 9,000 people taking part in 2024! Our popular Farm Camp sold out for the 6th year in a row! Farm Tours and WMG continued strong and StoryTime continues to draw visitors every Wednesday and Thursday with farmthemed stories and activities to keep little ones involved and active. Our education team developed new displays placed around the farm for everyone to enjoy while learning something new about farm life! Plus, our "story walk" around the pond contiues to be updated monthly and our "little library" is always loaded with books to take home.

ANIMALS

In 2024, we added to our farm animal family including 2 Giant

Flemish Rabbits, 7 Mini Nigerian Goats, 5 Jacob Sheep Ewes and 2 Jacob Sheep Rams, 16 Chickens (Silver laced and Golden laced Wyandottes, Light Brahma, Buff Orpington) and 9 Cayuga Ducks!

- Farm House roof was replaced. Its side porch was updated with new shingles, railings, floor leveling and paint

- A new monthly newsletter "Down on the Farm" was developed and debuted early in 2025.
